

SAJCF WATER PROJECT LOCATIONS

In 2013, seven (7) concrete lined wells were successfully dug in the following villages and now provide clean water to those communities:

- Barianding (Jokado , NBR)
- Kerr Biran Kane (Upper Niumi, NBR)
- Fass Omar Saho (Upper Niumi, NBR)
- Kerr Demba Holeh (Upper Niumi, NBR)
- Njabakunda (Lower / Central Baddibu, NBR)
- Saliekene (Central Baddibu, NBR)
- Kinteh Kunda (Lower / Central Baddibu, NBR)

In 2014, the Foundation facilitated the digging of a borehole at a Quranic School in the village of Samba Kalla in the North Bank Region (NBR) of the country.

Building on the first two years of its water initiative success, in 2015, SAJCF successfully constructed ten (10) concrete lined wells in the NBR, Central River Region (CRR) and Upper River Region (URR), along with one (1) borehole in the following villages resulting in accessibility to clean water:

- Kerr Lowen (NBR)
- Kerr Layen (NBR)
- Fass Omar Saho (Upper Niumi, NBR)
- Bouniadou (CRR)
- Sarre Giddeh (CRR)
- Bantato (CRR)
- Sarre Soffie (CRR)
- Medina Toujang (CRR)
- Dampha Kunda (URR)
- Tinkijo (URR)
- Jahanka (CRR) - construction of borehole

In 2016, SAJCF successfully expanded on its water relief operations by installation of major solar water pumping systems supplying water to ten tap heads in Upper River Region (URR) and Central River Region (CRR). The first set of systems were built in the communities of Darsilameh and Brikamading in CRR. The other system was built in Sandu Jakaba in URR for its community. The communities at these locations were in much need of clean and regular supply of water. The establishment of the exceptionally large water systems has made a big difference to the communities as it supplies 50000 litres of clean drinking water daily to each location. The Foundation has also assisted the communities in establishing a management committee to oversee the sustainability and maintenance of the newly established system in years to come.

In 2018, SAJCF further expanded its water initiative to Njankul in Upper River Region (URR); where it installed a borehole with 11 water supply tap heads.

In 2019, the Foundation also installed an additional 2 boreholes, one in Samba Tako (CRR) and one serving Santanto Mawdo (CRR) and Santanto Buby (CRR) villages. Each borehole has a minimum of 11 water tap heads.

The Foundation's collaboration work with other agencies was also greatly boosted when U.S Peace Corp donated a hand pump to one of SAJCF's well projects in URR in the village of Tinkijo.
